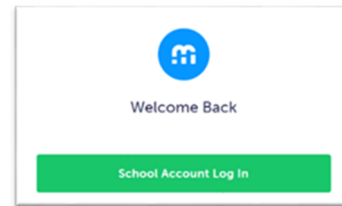


Sinclair Secondary School Course Selection

This step-by-step guide will help you complete online course selection using the myBlueprint website.

LOGGING ON TO MY BLUEPRINT

1. Visit www.myblueprint.ca/ddsb
2. Select the green "School Account Login"
3. The website uses your DDSB credentials. Enter your DDSB student number and password, click Login



SELECTING YOUR LEARNING MODE FOR NEXT YEAR

The DDSB is transitioning all students in the DDSB@Home back to their home schools where each school will be providing programming for students in a Face to Face or a Synchronous Virtual learning environment. All students will return to the semestered system next year and have 4 classes each day. Students **cannot** mix the delivery choice and must select their classes all from one or the other, Face to Face OR Synchronous Virtual.

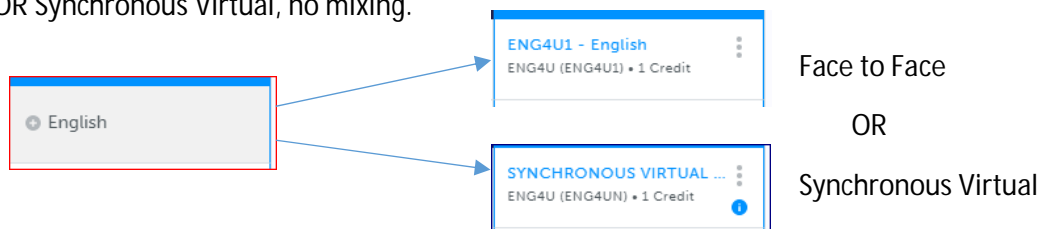
* **Face to Face** – Classes taught in Sinclair. The course descriptions are our traditional descriptions.

* **Synchronous Virtual** – Classes taught online by a live Sinclair teacher for the full 75 minute period. These courses have the Synchronous Virtual name clearly in the course title.

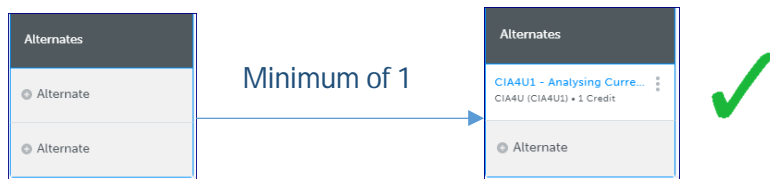
** **Asynchronous eLearning** - Online classes where students schedule their own time to independently work on their course material. Students access support for the class but communicating with their teacher through email. These classes are available in Grade 11 and 12 and are the only classes available for both Face to Face and Synchronous Virtual students. Asynchronous classes are offered through the DDSB/OELC and students can select up to two classes a year through this; however, Sinclair has chosen to also offer an Asynchronous Online class, HSP3UL – Intro to Anthropology/Psychology/Sociology, which students can select in addition to the two OELC classes. Students select Asynchronous classes under the Asynchronous eLearning Course discipline. Students will select an eLearning placeholder, STUDYE, and then select which Asynchronous class they would like to add.

COMPLETING COURSE SELECTIONS

1. From your Dashboard, click on the High School button on the left menu. This will open up your High School Planner.
2. Students will add courses to their planner by clicking on the course boxes, searching for the course code and selecting the appropriate course. Students must remember to select ALL courses from either Face to Face OR Synchronous Virtual, no mixing.



3. Selecting Alternate Courses!! New this year we will be timetabling using alternates. What this means is when building schedules the computer may substitute one of your optional courses with one of your alternates when making your schedule. So that means students need to select your alternate(s) carefully. **All students need to select one alternate** but myBlueprint allows you to select up to two alternates should you choose.



4. Planning on taking Summer School?

- a) If the class is a compulsory then you must select it in your plan. Then add a second alternate to represent the class you want to substitute for the compulsory class.
- b) During the review process, please add a Guidance note in your My Blueprint planner to inform us of your plans to take summer school
- c) On April 1st, please remember to log back into My Blueprint and register for your summer school course. In order to register, you will need to work under the Continuing Education tab in My Blueprint menu. You are NOT registered unless you complete this step.

5. Review and Submit your Course Selections fast and easy.

During the Review step you have the ability to add a Guidance message to clarify issues such as if you are trying to take a class but don't have the pre-req until after you take the class in summer school.

Once submitted, click the send your parent/guardian an email for them to approve your selections. Due to COVID-19 we are only accepting electronic parent/guardian signatures.
