This course focuses on guidelines for making nutritious food choices. Students will investigate factors that influence food choices, including beliefs, attitudes, current trends, traditional eating patterns, food-marketing strategies, and individual needs. Students will also explore the environmental impact of a variety of food choices at the local and global level. The course provides students with opportunities to develop food-preparation skills and introduces them to the use of social science research methods in the area of food and nutrition.



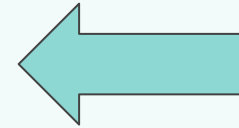

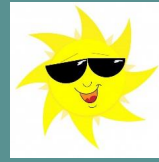

## Credit Recovery

- Two 2 week blocks in July (Semester 1 and 2)
- Most courses offered are core courses – (Arts, Technology, P.E. etc. are not available)
- Students must have achieved a mark of 35% - 49% to be eligible
- S1
- S2 (Schools and format to be determined).

## Accelerated

- Four week course in July
- Grade 10, 11 and 12 courses
- Most courses are in Science, Math, English, and Careers and Civics.
- eLearning S1 July
- eLearning S2 August

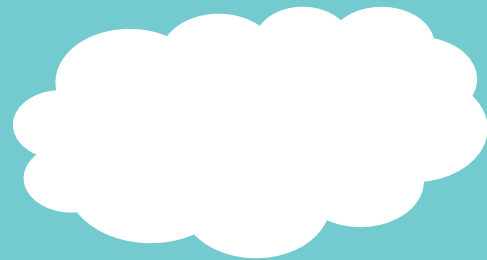
# If you plan on attending summer school...

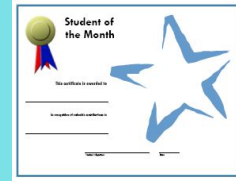

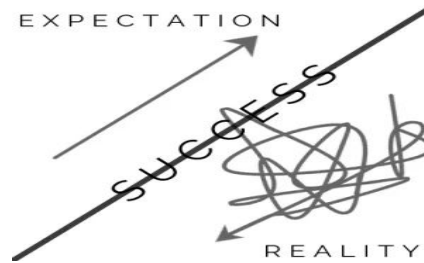
- When you choose courses, it is important that you do some honest self-assessment, matching your ability with your interests and aptitudes.
