Our OSSLT Test will be taking place on March 31st.

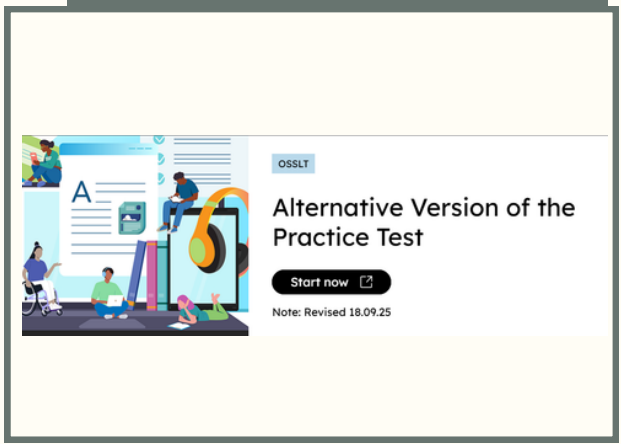
Student support for Literacy

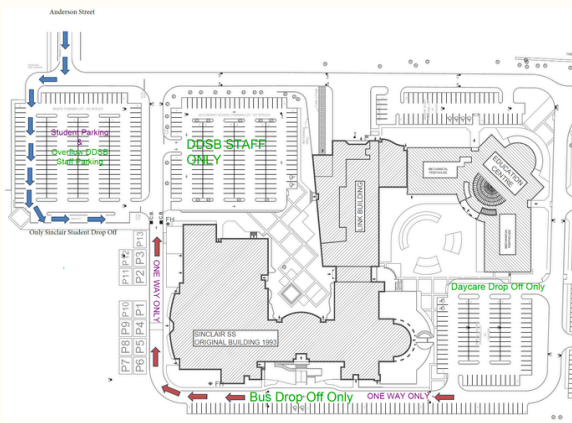
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Reminders
