Summatives and Exam Information Continued

- The exam schedule will be made available on the school website and on Grade Level Google Classrooms at the end of May.
- Exams begin at 9:30 am and run for 1.5 or 2.0 hours. Students are responsible for arriving on time with suitable writing supplies.
- Students arriving late for any exam must report to the main office. Students arriving late will be given the remaining allotted time to write the exam.
- School buses will be running on their regular schedule on exam days.
- If buses are cancelled for any reason or in the event of a school closure, exams scheduled for that day will be moved to June 23rd, 2026.
- Only those students who have an exam are required to attend school on the day of their exam.
